Introductory Overview

Key Points in Mission Statement

- The Courageous Steps Project shall support local programs that help young children with challenges. This includes, but is not limited to, the challenges of: Autism, ADD, ADHD, Down Syndrome, Anxiety Disorders, Organic Mental Disorders, PTSD, Schizophrenia, Chronic Pain, Chronic Migraines, Vision Loss, Hearing Loss, Dyslexia, and other Learning Disabilities/Speech and Language Disorders. If a person is unsure of if they would qualify for a donation or support, they should contact the executive director.
- The Courageous Steps Project shall also support local children with challenges going back to school with school supplies, in the form of scholarship funds, and other initiatives of the Courageous Steps Project that apply.
- The Courageous Steps Project shall create awareness campaigns, media or not, that are related to these causes. In Exhibit A, it says that these awareness campaigns can only generate revenue for charitable purposes.
- The Courageous Steps Project's Exhibit A document says, "No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any director or other individual. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation no director or other individual shall be entitled to any distribution or division of its remaining property or proceeds. The balance of all money and other property received by the Corporation from any source, including its operations, after the payment of all debts and obligations of the Corporation of whatsoever kind and nature, shall be used or distributed exclusively for charitable purposes as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code."
