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Mission of Wishlist Initiative

The Courageous Steps Project continues to expand into different communities by providing resources and awareness to organizations who have aspirations to help more children and young adults. In 2016, The Courageous Steps Project launched its wishlist initiative to help classroom teachers around Maine fulfill their mission to help children with developmental challenges to feel included in the regular education classroom setting.

Requirements:

- Wishlist grants cannot be over \$500.00.
- Wishlist requests may be compromised due to Courageous Steps budget.
- All teachers must sign the appropriate forms mailed or given by Courageous Steps.
- All teachers must take pictures of their products used in the classroom.
- A limit of five (5) teachers from each Maine school can receive a Wishlist grant per year.

How does it work, and what is involved?

School teachers send a wish list of items that they would like for their classroom. All wish lists must match the mission of The Courageous Steps Project. Wishlist grants are a first come first serve basis.
